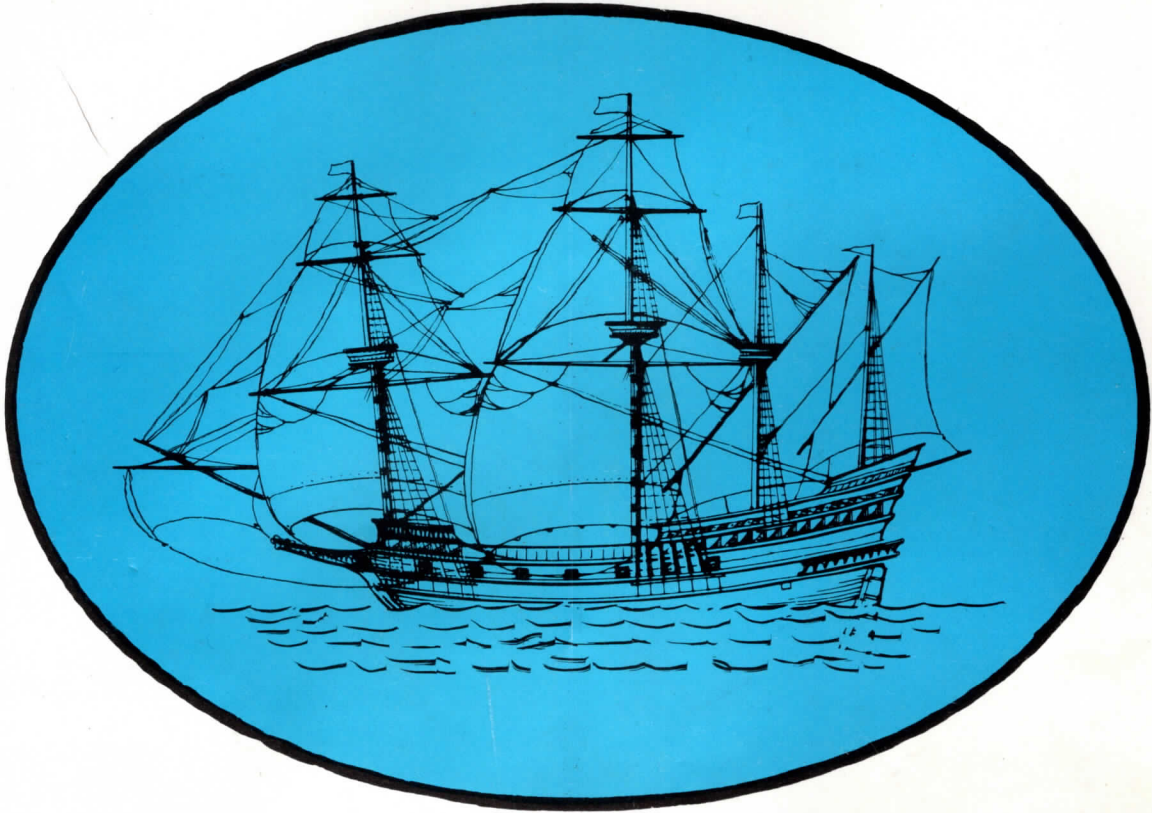
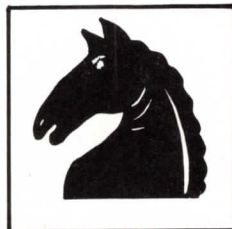

B.C.F. COUNCIL MEETING 14 JULY 1979.

Players who play for more than one County in various competitions will be pleased to know that Rule 7 of the Registration Scheme Rules has been deleted. In future, one act of registration will be sufficient.

The proposal from Devon, supported by the Union, that the draw for the Counties Quarter-Finals be made in January of each year was carried by 25 votes to 7.

For the 1979/80 Season the draw for the Minor Counties Championship is as follows :-

S.C.C.U. v N.C.C.U.  
M.C.C.U. v W.E.C.U.

The BCF is launching an appeal to meet the cost of sending a second with Tony Miles to the Yurmala Interzonal in September. Tony is the first Briton to reach an Interzonal since 1952 and it is generally agreed that the presence of a second will be a great aid to his playing resources in Latvia and, of equal importance, provide moral support in a remote part of a foreign land.

The Council suggested that any contributions which County Associations might care to make should be pitched at the level of £3.00 per levy point. Contributions from other BCF affiliates should be whatever amount they deem appropriate. The appeal is also made to existing benefactors of the game (£200 has already been raised from this source) and to the individual player. The amount required is around £850.00.

WORDS AND NAMES.

Mr. H. Golding is quite correct, of course, in stating that the West of England Chess Association was founded in 1947. The Association consisted of the Counties Cornwall, Devon, Dorset, Gloucestershire, Monmouth and Somerset who were part of the S.C.C.U. However, even at the first annual meeting held in 1948 a resolution proposing the formation of a Western Counties Union and consequent secession from the S.C.C.U. was put forward! Enquiries and discussion on this subject followed year after year until in 1957 at the 9th Annual General Meeting, a proposal that "The Association should adopt the title of The West of England Chess Union and apply to the B.C.F. for recognition as a constituent unit of that body" was carried, and the following year the first annual meeting of the W.E.C.U. was held. I sincerely hope that the West of England Chess Union will retain its caption "Founded 1947", which was its real beginning.

It would appear that, in the South, there is an attempt to make an additional charge to registered players either by way of Congress levy or payment by event. In the West NO additional payment is made or would be tolerated. But then, of course, the West of England throughout history has always been a little radical in its outlook.

## WEST OF ENGLAND CHESS UNION.

### GENERAL RULES.

#### 1. TITLE

This association shall be known as the "West of England Chess Union" and the term "West of England" shall mean such of the following Counties as may from time to time be affiliated :-

Cornwall, Devon, Dorset, Gloucestershire, Hampshire, Somerset and Wiltshire, and such other Counties as may upon application be approved by the Council.

#### 2. OBJECTS

The objects of the Union shall be :-

- (a) to encourage the study and practice of chess in the West of England and to discover and encourage chess talent, particularly among young players.
- (b) to promote and conduct an Annual Congress (including a contest for the individual chess championship of the West of England), a County championship competition for the West of England, and such other competitions, matches and events as may from time to time be decided.
- (c) to participate in national chess activities.

#### 3. REGISTRATION AND SUBSCRIPTIONS

- (a) The W.E.C.U. makes it a condition of affiliation that each County shall fully implement the British Chess Federation Registration scheme by endeavouring to ensure that all affiliated clubs register all members, and comply with the procedure for forwarding registrations to the Union Registration Secretary through County officials.
- (b) Each County shall pay :-
  - (i) Annually to the Union in respect of every registered member the sum fixed by the Annual Council Meeting.

- (ii) Annually the sum fixed by the Annual Council Meeting into the fund of the Union, from which County delegates and officers attending Union Executive and Council Meetings shall be entitled to recover their travelling expenses.
- (iii) A board fee per player, being the sum fixed by the Annual Council Meeting, in respect of any match sponsored by the Union, in addition to board fees required by the BCF.

#### 4. OFFICERS

- (a) The Union shall have the following officers :-  
President, two or more Vice Presidents, Secretary, Secretary for Junior Chess, Congress Secretary, Publicity Officer, Grading Officer, Treasurer; and, if and whenever necessary, an Assistant Secretary, and such other officers as the Council may appoint.
- (b) It shall be lawful for one person to hold simultaneously two (but no more) of these offices.

#### 5. DELEGATES

- (a) Each affiliated County shall nominate two Union delegates.
- (b) Every delegate shall continue qualified until he is either replaced by a new effective nomination by his County or elected as an officer of the Union.
- (c) No nomination shall be effective until proper written notice thereof is received by the Secretary of the Union.
- (d) A delegate replaced by his County shall nevertheless continue, until the next meeting of the Council, to be a member of any Committee of the Union to which he has previously been elected or co-opted.

#### 6. COUNCIL

- (a) The Union shall be governed by a Council comprising of the officers of the Union and the delegates of the Counties for the time being affiliated.
- (b) A Special Meeting of the Council shall be called by the Secretary within one month of the receipt by him of a written requisition clearly stating the nature of the business to be transacted and signed either by not fewer than five members of the Executive Committee or by the responsible officers of not fewer than two affiliated Counties.
- (c) At least fourteen days before the date of every Annual or Special Meeting the Secretary shall send to all Council members and to the Secretaries of all affiliated Counties notice of the business to be transacted. Such agenda shall include any business of which notice has been given by any Council member to the Secretary.
- (d) Each Council member shall have one vote. Five members present shall be a quorum. Members of affiliated Counties who are not Council members may attend Council meetings and with the Chairman's permission may take part in discussions but shall have no voting power.

## 7. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- (a) Subject to the Council's control the Union shall be managed by an Executive Committee consisting of the officers (other than Vice Presidents) and one member from each affiliated County within the Union.
- (b) Meetings of the Executive Committee shall be convened as necessary by the President or Secretary. Four members present shall be a quorum.
- (c) Except in cases of urgency at least seven days' notice of the time, place and agenda shall be given to members.
- (d) The Executive Committee shall have power to fill any vacancy occurring during its year; to co-opt; to constitute sub-committees and to appoint one of its members to act for the time being in place of any officer of the Union who shall be unable or unwilling to continue in his office.
- (e) The Executive Committee shall elect from its members such delegates as the Union is for the time being entitled to nominate to the British Chess Federation or any other body.

## 8. ANNUAL BUSINESS

- (a) The Treasurer shall receive, manage and account for the moneys of the Union and shall prepare and cause to be audited an annual account and balance sheet for the year ending on the 30th April.
- (b) At its Annual Meeting the Council shall receive and examine reports by the officers and the audited annual account and balance sheet for the previous financial year.
- (c) At the same meeting, the Council shall elect the officers and Selection Committee for the ensuing year, and shall appoint an auditor. To ensure rotation of the office of President of the Union, a new appointment shall be made at the end of every third year. The retiring President shall not be eligible for immediate re-appointment.
- (d) Vacancies occurring during the year in any office or on any Committee may be filled by the Council at any Special Meeting, such a meeting may relieve any officer of his duties.

## 9. SELECTION COMMITTEE

- (a) Subject to the Council's control, the Selection Committee consisting of a Chairman and three other members with power to co-opt, shall make all necessary selections of players to take part in Union competitions or represent the Union in matches.
- (b) This Committee shall have power to require competition entrants to 'play off'.
- (c) Three members present shall be a quorum.
- (d) Save as specially directed by the Council, this Committee shall have no jurisdiction in respect of junior chess.

## 10. PROCEDURE

At all meetings of the Council or of any Committee or Sub-Committee :-

- (a) If the President (or in the case of the Selection Committee, the Chairman) be present he shall be chairman but if not the meeting shall elect its chairman.

- (b) Any member authorised to vote but unable to attend may give in writing to any other member a proxy vote to be used as he may direct.
- (c) In case of equality of votes the chairman shall have a casting vote.

#### 11. COMPETITION RULES

The West of England Championship, the West of England Ladies Championship, the West of England Challengers' Tournament, the West of England Championship Reserves, the West of England Junior (Boys') Championship, the West of England Girls' Championship, the West of England Minor Championship and the Open Championship competitions shall be conducted according to the rules set forth in Appendix A attached, and the West of England Counties Championship competition shall be conducted according to the rules set forth in Appendix B attached.

#### 12. DISSOLUTION

If a resolution to dissolve the Union shall be passed by the Council and shall be confirmed, at a Special Meeting of the Council held not less than one month here after at which not less than one half of the Council members shall be present in person, by a two-third majority of the votes cast, then the assets of the Union shall be realised and after its liabilities are discharged any remaining balance shall be divided between such Counties as were affiliated at the date of the original resolution in proportion to the aggregate of subscriptions paid by such Counties respectively during the ten years immediately preceding that date.

#### 13. ALTERATION OF RULES

No alteration or addition to these rules (other than the appendices) shall be made save by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast at a Council meeting upon a resolution set out in the agenda for such meeting, such agenda having been duly circulated under Rule 6(d). Notice of proposed changes in rules at the Annual Meeting must reach the Secretary not later than 24th April.

## APPENDIX A

### Competition Rules for the West of England Congress

#### 1. DATE

The contests for these competitions shall take place, annually, at Easter.

#### 2. NUMBERS OF COMPETITIONS AND RULES OF PLAY

- a) The contest for the West of England Championship shall consist of a Swiss tournament of seven rounds between competitors to be selected by the selection committee. If this tournament produces two competitors with equal top points, they shall be regarded as joint champions but the superior sum of opponents' scores will decide who is eligible to represent the W.E.C.U. in the British Championship. If more than two tie, the Championship shall be determined by applying the sum of opponents' scores. In all cases, prize money will be shared for equal scores.
- b) The Challengers and Reserves sections shall be Swiss tournaments of 6 rounds. The Reserves may be divided into graded sections. The two highest placed eligible players in both the Challengers and Reserves A (should it be in sections) shall receive invitations to play in the Championship and Challengers sections respectively, for the following year. In the event of ties, the invitations shall be decided on the sum of opponents' scores.
- c) The Junior, Minor, Ladies and Girls Championships may be Swiss or American tournaments depending upon the entry.
- d) The Open Championship will, normally, be a six round Swiss tournament.
- e) There will be an All-Play-All tournament of graded sections with six players in each section.
- f) In all tournaments, any game still unfinished at 4.00pm on the final day will be sent for adjudication to the B.C.F. if a result cannot be agreed between the players.
- g) The Controller of the tournaments shall be appointed beforehand by the Congress Secretary. Any disputes will be adjudicated by the Controller in accordance with the Laws of Chess as laid down by the B.C.F. unless otherwise provided for by the Union rules. The Controller's decision shall be final.

#### 3. RATES OF PLAY

- a) Championship, Challengers, Reserves and Open
  - 34 moves in 2 hours in 4 hour sessions
  - 43 moves in 2½ hours in 5 hour sessions
  - 17 moves per hour thereafter.
- b) All other tournaments
  - 40 moves in 2 hours in 4 hour sessions
  - 50 moves in 2½ hours in 5 hour sessions
  - 20 moves per hour thereafter.

There will be a minimum of 4 hours play in any event before there is a time control.

#### 4. QUALIFICATION OF PLAYERS

The qualifications for a player to take part in the Championship, Challengers and Reserves tournaments shall be a bona fide subscribing membership of an affiliated county, either direct or through an affiliated club, and one of the following :-

- a) Birth in that County
- b) Five consecutive years residence in that County at any time.
- c) Present residence in that County from the 1st October immediately prior to the tournament.
- d) Two years immediately previous and present subscribing membership of an affiliated club in that County and resident within 25 miles of that club.
- e) Present attendance at a University in that County.
- f) Present attendance as a pupil at a college or school in that County.
- g) Present service as a member of H.M. Forces within that County.

The qualifications for a player to take a Trophy in the Junior, Girls or Minor Championships shall be one of the qualifications listed in a) or g) above and that each entrant shall be under the age of 18 years (Junior and Girls) and 15 years (Minor) on the 1st September preceding the tournament.

#### 5. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The committee for selecting entrants to the Championship shall consist of the Grading Officer, Congress Secretary, Match Captain and a representative of Junior Chess. In all other events, selection, as necessary, will be done by the Congress Secretary.

#### 6. ENTRANCE FEES

These shall be determined by the W.E.C.U. Executive at its autumn meeting. Entry fees may be refunded if a reasonable notice of withdrawal is given.

#### 7. TROPHIES

These shall be suitably engraved and the holders shall be entitled to retain them for 12 months, subject to giving a guarantee of safe custody satisfactory to the Insurance Company acting for the committee.

#### 8. PRIZES

Prizes, to approximately the value of entrance fees received, will be awarded to competitors in each tournament.

There will be 4 prizes in events with over 20 competitors, 3 prizes in events with 8 or over competitors.

## APPENDIX B

### Rules for the West of England Chess Union Counties Championship and Subsidiary Cup Competitions

1. Each County shall play each other one match and the winner shall be the County with the highest score, counting matches won as two points each, and matches drawn as one point each. Ties produced by this method shall be resolved in accordance with Rule 3.
2. If and when considered necessary by the Council, Rule 1 shall not apply but instead the competing Counties shall be grouped into two preliminary sections. The two section winners shall play a deciding match for the Union Championship (the title and trophy being held for one year). Within each preliminary section each County shall play each other one match and the section winner shall be the County with the highest score, counting matches won as two points and matches drawn as one point each. Ties produced by this method shall be resolved in accordance with Rule 3.
3. If no clear winner is reached in the match programme as detailed in either Rule 1 or Rule 2, the tie shall be resolved in the following manner :-  
In the event of a tie between two or more Counties the tie should be broken by taking the results of the matches between the tying Counties as follows :-
  - (A) On the points scored (counting two for a win and one for a draw), and if the tie remained,
  - (B) By games average, and if the tie remained,
  - (C) By the board count method, whereby each winning player scores the same number of points as his board number, and the team with the lowest number of points wins, and if the tie remained,
  - (D) By elimination rule, whereby counting from the lowest numbered board upwards, the first won game shall be deleted.
4. All play shall be governed by the Laws of Chess (as recognised by the British Chess Federation) and subject thereto by the following rules.:-
5.
  - (a) Harold Meek Cup: Matches between the Major Counties, Devon, Gloucestershire and Somerset shall be played on a minimum of thirty boards. All other matches shall be played on a minimum of twenty-four boards.
  - (b) All boards in matches between Minor Counties in 5(a) shall also count for the Minor Counties Cup.
  - (c) The first sixteen boards in each match shall count for the Counties Championship.
  - (d) One game shall be played on each board; a win shall count as one point and a draw half a point. The winner of the match shall be the County with the higher aggregate of points. If the two aggregates are equal the match shall be scored as a draw.
  - (e) In a deciding match under Rule 3, a draw shall be broken by Rule 3(c) and if the tie remains by Rule 3(d).
  - (f) Counties entering teams of 16 in both the English Counties and the Minor Counties championships shall nominate to the Secretary by 15th October, 14 players expected to play in the English Counties Championship and none of these shall be eligible to play in the Minor Counties Championship.

- (g) No player shall play for more than one County in a season, save that a registered player may play for one County in the Jamboree and for another County in the same Union and in the same season, in the English Counties Championship.
6. The date and venue of every match shall be fixed by the Executive Committee at the earliest practicable opportunity and notified by the Secretary to the Secretaries of all Counties concerned. In respect of any such match the opponent Counties may agree to substitute an alternative venue, but an alternative date may not be substituted except by unanimous agreement between the Secretary and both opponent Counties. Matches may be played by telephone.
  7. Play in every match shall be for not less than 3 hours (excluding intervals). Subject thereto, the times of commencement and end of play shall be prearranged between the opponent Counties in every match. Immediately before the time fixed for play the captains shall exchange playing lists and then toss for for move. The team whose captain shall have won the toss shall take the first move on the odd numbered boards. Players shall be arranged, as far as practicable, in their known order of strength.
  8. All games shall be played with clocks save where clocks are unobtainable. Where clocks are in use each player shall make not less than 36 moves in the first 90 minutes and thereafter six moves in every completed fifteen minutes, except as provided in Rule 9. Where time allows for  $3\frac{1}{2}$  hours play (excluding intervals) the rate of play shall be 42 moves in 105 minutes.
  9. Every game not previously decided must be continued until the time fixed for the termination of the match, but should it be desired to stop any particular game at an earlier hour than that fixed for such termination the consent of both players interested and of the two captains of the Counties engaged shall be obtained prior to the game being commenced, and the time control shall then be fixed (where clocks are in use).
  10. At the time fixed for the commencement of play the Captains shall be responsible for seeing that the clocks of the players having the move are started. If a player has not arrived at the end of the first hour his opponent, if present, shall score the game, unless a substitute be put in before the time of forfeit. A clock once started shall not be stopped or put back except in compliance with the Laws of Chess. If neither player of a pair has arrived at the end of the first hour, the game shall be scored as lost by both players. A match player debarred of a match game by reason of another player's default shall be reimbursed his travel expenses, up to a limit of £3.00, plus board fee, by the County having the default, such claim to be made in writing to the Union Match Captain.
  - 11.(a) After every match and within 10 days the responsible officer of each opponent County shall send to the Secretary the full score of the match indicating which games (if any) are subject to adjudication and shall promptly notify the results of any such adjudication to the Secretary immediately he receives them.  
  
(b) The penalty for non-compliance with this Rule shall be the deduction from the game-score or match-score of the offending County of such number of points as the Executive Committee deem appropriate to the circumstances.
  12. In the case of every match game unfinished at the end of play the opponent captains shall thereupon agree a result, or if unable to agree, shall within four days submit the game's final position for adjudication in accordance with the rules of the BCF,

Continued .....

13. The qualification of a player to represent a County in the competition shall be B.C.F. Registration and subscribing membership of the County Association (either direct or through an official organisation) together with one of the conditions set out in Appendix A Rule 4 (except condition 4(c), see below) PROVIDED that no player may represent more than one County in the course of a single season's competition. PROVIDED that a player properly so qualified and taking part in a match shall be deemed to remain qualified until the conclusion of that season's competition. For the purposes of this competition condition 4(c) shall read "Present residence and three month's residence immediately prior to the match".
  14. The penalty for playing unqualified players in any match shall be the deduction of two points in respect of each unqualified player from the total score made by the County in that match for which such unqualified player(s) shall have played.
  15. Any dispute between Counties as to the interpretation of these Rules or any other matter arising in the course of the competition shall forthwith be referred by the Counties in dispute to the Secretary; who shall refer the dispute to the Executive Committee for their decision (or in the case of extreme urgency shall decide the dispute in consultation with the President). Any County affected by any such decision may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, appeal to the Council of the Union at the earliest practicable opportunity, but in default of such appeal all such decisions shall be binding on all Counties.
  16. In the Appendix "the Secretary" means the Secretary of the Union or such other officer or individual as may for the time being be duly authorised by the Union to act in that behalf.
  17. In the annual Inter-County Jamboree match the Rules shall be in accordance with the Rules listed above, as far as applicable, except that, adjudication be by two neutral Captains or their deputies, and failing agreement, then by the Controller, whose decision be final.  
For resolving ties in this competition the following method shall be adopted :-
    - (a) Consider the scores of games in which members of the two teams concerned in the tie met each other. The side with the better score wins the event, and if the tie remained
    - (b) Add together the numbers of the boards at which each team won, to this total add half the numbers of the boards at which each team drew. The team with the lesser total wins, and if the tie remained
    - (c) By elimination rule, as detailed in Rule 3(d).The winning County of this event shall be awarded the "Bristol Cup", which shall be held for one year.

W.E.C.U. Hon. Grader's Report

In this Grading List we have continued our policy of not publishing the names of unregistered players. The names of those affected by this ruling have been included in the list in order to show that their grades have been calculated and are available. The procedure to follow in order to obtain these grades and have them published is detailed in the Registration Officer's comments which follow this report.

The qualifying requirements for a B.C.F. grade is: a minimum of 30 games during the last two seasons at least ten of which must have been played during the last season. If at least 30 games have been played during the last season, then results from the previous season are ignored when calculating the grade. Approximately 40% of the B.C.F. grades are so calculated.

Players who do not qualify for a B.C.F. grade, can have a Union grade, the requirement for which is: a minimum of 18 games during the last two seasons, at least eight of which must have been played during the last season. Those of you who remember our previous requirements will realise that this new basis will deprive a number of players from having a published grade. To avoid this, we have included those who would have qualified under our old requirements, but, we have marked their grade with a negative sign to indicate the grade is only an estimate. (The old requirements were: a minimum of 15 games during the last two seasons at least 5 of which must have been played during the last season or: a minimum of 10 games during the last season).

Certain players in our list play in other Unions (apart from Congresses) these players are indicated by the appropriate Union letter, which means that their grades are probably based on results from more than one Union. If there is anyone who thinks that he should have results from another Union and it is not indicated, would he please write to me giving details.
