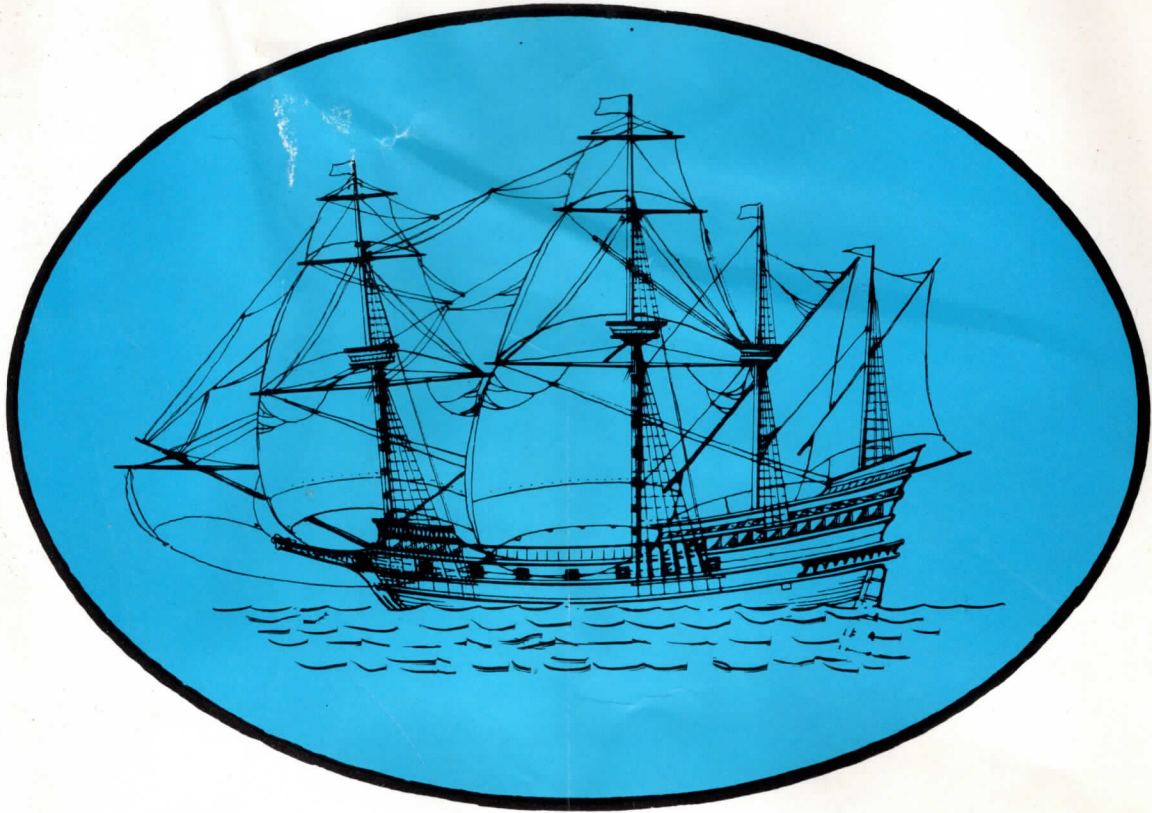

Once again the Western Union is proud to be first in the field in the publication of the Grading Issue and our thanks must go to the excellent work done by our Union Grader, Frank Kingdon, and all the County Graders and others who make this annual habit of publishing grades by the 1st September possible. One of the main reasons for early publication of grading lists is, of course, the ever-increasing number of congresses giving grading prizes and providing tournaments limited to certain grades. With the rapid seasonal improvement in junior grades, using an outdated grade leads to unfairness. It is hoped that, one day, all grading lists will be published prior to the commencement of the main chess season, but, at the moment, that is only a pious hope owing to the relative sizes of other Unions compared with our own. However, with the forecasted large cash boost envisaged by the authors of payment for grading at congresses perhaps there will be funds available for speeding up this very necessary step forward to greater efficiency. We can only hope!

The Union starts its season with the famous Paignton Congress at Oldway Mansion, Paignton followed, at the end of the month, by the Union Jamboree - the biggest one day get together in the Union calendar. After that, follows a full programme of chess including County Championships, Junior Championships, Individual Championships, Congresses, Lightning Tournaments, Quick Play, County League Matches, School Leagues - in fact, everything to interest and occupy all chess players from the Beginners to the Expert - and all provided by a Union proud to be West - and Best!

WEST OF ENGLAND CONGRESSES COULD COST MORE!!

At the Council Meeting of the BCF held at the Centre Hotel in Birmingham on 12th July, a resolution was passed that gave Congresses the right to affiliate to the BCF and have representation at the Council through one of 4 regional Congress delegates. The cost of such affiliation would be by payment of a sum equivalent to 10p for every game played at the Congress. The benefits would be to have assurance that all games would be graded and that advice, assistance and help be given from the BCF via the Congress Director. Congresses that were run by a Union or County for their own sole financial benefit or burden would have free affiliation.

The scheme is voluntary but Congresses that do not join may be in jeopardy of not having their games graded.

What, of course, everybody in the West of England will want to know is how are congresses in the West affected and, if they do not join, will their games be graded.

The short answer is that certainly for the next year the WECU Union Grader has stated quite categorically that all games of all congresses played in the Union will be graded if results are sent to him through the usual channels.

Examples of Congresses that are automatically affiliated are the West of England Easter Congress, the Paignton Congress and the Dorset Congress.

Congresses such as the Hexagon, East Devon, North Devon and Basingstoke are not affiliated as they are not run for the sole financial benefit or burden of the Union or County. The grading of their games, however, is assured whether they join this new scheme or not.

At the Council Meeting the West of England put amendments to the main proposals that Congresses that were affiliated to a Union or County and/or Congresses that only accept registered players be exempt was heavily defeated.

The logic behind this vote is a little obscure. One of the advantages or privileges of registration is to have the right to the grading services of the BCF. It would now appear that registered players in the Western Union who participate in a Congress outside the Union will have to pay again in order to ensure their games go for grading. Somehow or other, this smacks of double taxation, a system the long-suffering British Public have protestingly accepted over the ages.

Of course, the advocates of this new super tax will say that it will increase the revenue of the BCF and thus decrease the annual levy increase. The more sceptical may well question the latter part of that statement and substitute the time-proven saying "The more you have, the more you spend".

ENGLISH COUNTIES AND MINOR COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIPS

A resolution from the Southern Counties to increase the number of boards from 16 to 20 in the BCF stages of these competitions was defeated at the Council Meeting by 26 votes to 16.

In view of the fact that one of the largest of the Southern Counties defaulted completely in the semi-final stages of the Minor Counties Championship being "unable to raise a team" perhaps this was just as well.

JUNIOR CHESS IN THE BRISTOL & DISTRICT CHESS LEAGUE

44 school teams compete in the 7 divisions of the Bristol & District Junior Chess Association. Each team plays 2 matches against all their opponents in each division making a total of 234 matches. This is quite a feat and shows great credit to the organisers.

Division 1 was won by Cotham "A" with Bristol Grammar coming in second. Other Cotham teams were runners up in Divisions 2 and 5. Grange won the championships of Divisions 5 and 6 and were runners up in Division 3 - in fact, they only lost one of the 30 matches played by their 3 teams, winning 20 and drawing 9.

UNION JAMBOREE, 1980

The Union Senior and Graded Jamboree will be held at the Rougemont Hotel, Exeter, on Saturday 4th October at 2.30pm sharp.

All Counties wishing to enter for the Senior Jamboree are requested to notify the Union Match Captain not later than 27th September. Teams must consist of 12 players.

Entries for the Graded Jamboree are due by the same date. The teams must consist of 12 players whose grades are 125 or below as published in this grading list. Any County, league or chess organisation in the Union may enter a team for this event. The cost per team including tea is £7.20 (60p per player).

COUNTY AND MINOR COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIPS

All County Match Captains are reminded of the importance of sending in results of County Matches and adjudications to the Union Match Captain as soon as possible after the event. Those Counties participating in both the English Counties and the Minor Counties must send to the Union Match Captain prior to the date of the first match a list of 14 players in the English Counties Competition who are not eligible for playing in the Minor Counties team.

This season Union Board fees were increased at the AGM and are now 10p per board. These Union board fees should be remitted direct to Mr. Grant, Union Treasurer.

CORRESPONDENCE CHESS IN DEVON

It is a pleasure to report that correspondence chess is, happily, on the upgrade in Devon - as to the extent of interest shown and as to results achieved.

During the season which ended in July 1979 Devon finished equal first in the 2nd division with $20\frac{1}{2}$ points out of 30; they achieved promotion to division 1 and as they had the better "board count" they became champions. Our County had been in division 1 before but had never before been holders of the Sinclair Trophy - an impressive shield about 2 feet tall (which now adorns my lounge at home).

We reckoned it would be difficult to sustain a place in the top society but at present (June 1980) we stand $7\frac{1}{2}$ - $7\frac{1}{2}$ with considerable promise from some of the outstanding games.

Now nothing succeeds like success and it has become possible to get a 2nd team (of 20 boards) going, together with a few reserves and the first 4 results which came through were wins. 4 - 0 was a happy start and although inevitably a nought appeared on the score sheet we now stand at 5 - 2 with chances of finishing in the top half.

I am told that next year the 2nd division will be split into 2 divisions. So many teams were in this league that the proper function of the Jamboree system was being eroded - eg: every County was playing some of the other Counties on only one board - hardly representative. I hear that there will be 30, 30, 20, 20 boards in the new 4 divisions and this will certainly cause some Counties (including Somerset with 8 teams) to review their entries.

May I say that postal chess improves your game and gives you the chance to study the openings in depth; you would probably not study the opening or defence in such detail over the board or when reading a book on the subject but making one move at a time and comparing with a text book gives you much more insight. It does your game good and remember that the opening is the foundation of the game, even if the middle game is the highlight before the mopping up at the end.

I shall be glad to hear of or from any registered player, whatever his grade, interested in playing postal chess, not only for the County but in the individual tournaments between players within Devon.

WHAT IS A CHAMPION ?

An interesting point was raised at the BCF Council Meeting. Should the British Champion be automatically granted a place in the Zonal. Most unfortunately the British Champion is not necessarily the best English player as some of our top players do not enter for a variety of reasons, such as participation in other events. However, the honour of winning the British Championship should surely be worthy of recognition and, perhaps if automatic entry to the Zonal was given, a stronger entry would be made in the British Championships. Regrettably, other championships, especially County Championships, seem to be losing their appeal. In some cases, the attraction of congresses with the ever-increasing prize monies detracts from championships and weakens County teams. Fortunately, in the West, the West of England Championship is still well supported and the County team

championships still have their appeal and are keenly fought. Nevertheless, there is evidence that the English Counties and the Minor Counties Championships are losing their support in other parts of the Country. In a way, this is understandable. To play in a County match may involve travelling a round trip of 200 miles or more, and, with the crippling cost of travel, may cause hardship. It is all rather sad.

PUBLICATION OF GRADES

The WECU continues its policy of non-publication of unregistered players. The North of England is now doing the same. Counties in the Midlands are withholding grades for unregistered players. More and more are coming round to the view of the West, but the powerful giants in the South are adamant. There is no way that their complicated machinery can cope - even if they wanted to. Well, that is democracy. It has been correctly pointed out that the BCF cannot instruct a Union to do something that it does not wish to. It can, of course, debar them from Union entries for British Championships - provided it alters its rules. That is most unlikely and it is to be hoped will never happen.

The strength of British Chess should - and does - lie with the Unions. On most points they are in agreement. On publication or non-publication of grades they differ - and will probably continue to do so for a long long time. One thing is certain - chess will continue to be played on an ever-increasing scale. There will be more inter-Union disagreements - and still chess will flourish.

Perhaps, if all Unions meekly agreed on all points of view, chess might suffer. We all might lose our aggressive determination to win - be it a game of chess or an inter-Union dispute. If that is so, long live the disputes!

BOOK REVIEW

The Chess Competitor's Handbook published by B.T. Batsford

This is probably the most comprehensive book published on the organisation and control of chess congresses, tournaments and competitions.

Not only does the author cover every type of competitive chess but the intricacies of the Swiss pairing systems are gone into in great depth. It is interesting to quote from the rules and guide lines for seeded pairings used by the London Chess Association :-

"Players at Swiss system events should enjoy themselves as much as is reasonably possible. For instance, pairing together relatives, members of the same club or from the same distant area, or contestants with a difference of 300 Elo (about 40 BCF) rating points should be avoided. Also entrants generally prefer to play, rather than win by default."

Other chapters make clear the responsibilities of organisers and controllers and this should prove of great value to all congress organisers.

Every type of congress and tournament is covered and explanation and interpretation of the laws of chess - including conduct of the players! - set out clearly and comprehensively.

There is little doubt in my mind that this book is an authority on the organisation of competitive chess.

However, I have one criticism. Why on earth is it called "The Chess Competitor's Handbook"? Organisers, club secretaries and controllers, glancing at the title on a bookstall crowded with chess books of every type, shape and size would probably not even bother to open it, whereas a name such as "The Controllers and Organisers Handbook" would give justice to this excellently prepared book and attract sales in the right market. As MCO is a must to most chess players, surely this book is a must for organisers, controllers and club secretaries.

WEST OF ENGLAND CHESS UNION - JULY 1980

General Secretary's Report On B.C.F. Meetings.

For the coming year Mr. D. Perrott (Wilts) takes the place of Mr. D. Woodruff as your second representative on the B.C.F. Management Board. Mr. R.H.T. Newman represents the W.E.C.U. on the B.C.F. Council. At the BCF Council Meeting on 12th July we had full representation from Counties with the exception of Cornwall.

1. B.C.F. Judges: Mr. D.C. Jarrett and Dr. I. Roebuck were among those awarded this title at the June Management Board Meeting. This title, however, is now replaced with the title of BCF Arbiter and in future applicants will be required to pass a simple test of knowledge of the Laws and basic tournament procedures, be members of the BCF, and be vouched for by a reputable source before taking the test. Those requiring details apply to the BCF.

2. B.C.F. Meetings 1980/81:

Council Meetings: Budget (Levy) 16th May, 1981, London.
Annual Meeting 11th July, 1981, Birmingham.

Management Board: 13th Sept., 1980 - Grading & Congress.
15th Nov., 1980 - Finance & Admin. Budget.
24th Jan., 1981 - Junior Chess.
21st March 1981 - International.
20th June 1981 - Home Chess & Publicity.

3. County Championships:

English Counties Championship won by Middlesex.
Minor Counties Championship won by Yorkshire.

In the E.C.C. Nottinghamshire conceded their quarter-final match to Lancashire because 26 April clashed with the Notts Congress. In the M.C.C. Middlesex II

could not raise a team for their sem-final against Yorkshire II on 10th May as it was Cup Final Day!

Unions have been asked for their views on dates for 1981 before these are fixed.

A proposal from S.C.C.U. that the Final (National) Stage of the E.C.C. and M.C.C. be played over a minimum of 20 Boards was defeated at the Council Meeting.

4. Minor Club Championship:

All Chess Clubs should receive details of the Minor Club Championship which is being launched this year and is based on an idea originally suggested by K. Schofield of Devon. It is for 5 board teams, with no team member graded over 174 and only one graded over 160.

Entry fee £2.50. Entries to P. Buswell, B.C.F. Closing date 30th September, 1980.

5. County Matches:

The Director of Home Chess asks that Counties think about alternatives to adjudications in County matches. Your views to the W.E.C.U. Match Captain, please.

6. Congress Affiliation:

Counties have had full details of the proposals re Congress Affiliation. At the Council Meeting it was agreed that there should be four representatives on the Council, one from each Union area. However, only fee paying congresses may nominate. Those congresses who are entitled to affiliate without payment (i.e. which are run by and for the sole financial benefit or burden of Constituent Units, Territorial Affiliates or Non-Territorial Affiliates) will have all the other benefits, but will not nominate for representation, unless, of course, they wish to subscribe.

7. Grading:

The future centralisation of the grading system was discussed at the June meeting and the Board have agreed to accept the free offer of Computer System Analyst to study the BCF's requirements in this field. His report should be ready for discussion at the November meeting. All Unions gave their views on centralisation, your W.E.C.U.'s being put as follows :-

We are reluctant to exchange our present system which is fast, efficient and free, unless the same standard can be maintained.

8. New Ideas:

It has been suggested to the Director of Home Chess that awards might be made by the BCF on the lines of "Chess Journalist(s) of the Year" and a "Services to Chess" medal. Comments and any further suggestions to Mr. P.M. Shaw, Director of Home Chess, 47 Summerville Gardens, Cheam, Sutton, Surrey, SM1 2BU.

CHESS SIMULTANEOUS DISPLAY

On Thursday, 26th June, at the Oasis Leisure Centre in Swindon 28 hopefuls sat down to play Tony Miles in a simultaneous exhibition by the English Grand Master. The display was put on as part of the Thamesdown-Hambro Festival and responsibility for organising and supervising on the night was given to the North Wiltshire Chess League through its Secretary, Terry Higgs.

The County Chess Association was represented by the Treasurer, and most clubs in the area had representatives taking part.

The evening proved highly successful, both with the contestants and spectators, the final result 4 defeats and 7 draws is probably not quite fair to Tony Miles as, due to time pressures, he conceded a defeat and 3 draws which with further play could possibly have been turned in his favour.

A special mention to 9 year old Dereck Dickinson, an up and coming young man, who went to 37 moves before resigning and then only lost through pawn inferiority. By the number of youngsters present, and the enthusiasm shown, the future looks bright for chess in Wiltshire.

YOU LUCKY PEOPLE

The Western Union, amongst other things, gives you a grade if you have played sufficient games to warrant it. Your Union fee per annum is 10p. This covers all the administrative and other work carried out by the Union. No charge is made by the Grading Officers for all the time that they put in. However, if all you got for your 10p was grading the cost would be :-

20 games played - .5p per game
40 games played - .25p per game
60 games played - .16p per game

In view of what is going on in other parts of the Country, this is very good food for thought - and that's a nice smug note to finish on.

"Dear Sir,

Congratulations on a very interesting issue of "Westward Ho!" recently received, highlighted by Mr. Brown's report of the Weymouth Easter Congress with its many excellent games.

I must, however, take issue with him on one matter. In his preamble, he thanks David LeMoir for "translating those (games), as necessary, into a sensible notation".

Since the games appear in descriptive notation, I deduce that he considers that notation to be more sensible than algebraic. I take entirely the opposite

view; the algebraic is more concise, more precise and free from the ambiguities of the descriptive, and I cannot see any advantage of the latter. This is not only true of actual game scores but also of annotations. Even in your report of the Weymouth Congress, which has obviously been very carefully written and edited, there are a number of ambiguous moves. A few examples :-

Boyce - Anthony 17 Q-B4
Andrews - Shire 21 N-B3
Goodland & Aitken 8 B-N5 (it is clear that Dr. Aitken himself was algebraic)
LeMoir - Boyce 16 NxP and 33 BxP
Andrews - Cook 22 B-B4
Goodland - Shire 12 P-B3
Staples - Cook 28 R-B7
Moore - Shutler 33 P-R3
Swift - Newman 8 Q-N3
Heasman - Gyton 13 --- BxN

Admittedly, some of the alternative moves would be pointless, weak, stupid or even suicidal but the errors of notation are there and, I suggest, would not have occurred in algebraic.

The only argument I can think of in favour of the descriptive notation is the Englishman's natural resistance to change - such as was made against decimalisation - and how much easier that is than pounds, shillings and pence, with those horrible odd farthings.

"Dear Sir,

As a county grading officer, I generally receive many indignant letters from players who swear that their grade is at least 4 or 5 points below what it should be. I examine my records and find that the results I have graded are correct but the player concerned according to his records has played more games than I have on my records.

Nine times out of ten, it is found that, either a club secretary or a tournament organiser, has omitted to send results in time for inclusion - despite pleas at all levels for this to be done.

Another real headache that I experience is I quite frequently find no initials put in front of a players name, or the wrong ones. If his name happens to be Smith or Brown that can cause quite a lot of confusion. A classic example of this was in league results submitted last season. Board No. 2 on all the results was the same surname. 5 matches were played and this gentleman had 3 different initials!! A check revealed that he had no brothers, sisters or club companions with a similar surname. What his initials were is still a closely guarded secret.

Moral If you are a club or league secretary, please ensure names and initials are (a) correct (b) legible and (c) consistent. It would also help if all results were sent in.

LATE POST

"Dear Sir,

I read with some amusement your comments published in the last issue under the heading of "Congresses and All That". I would suggest to the BCF General Secretary that either the office is moved to Bristol or he joins a club playing the Bristol & District League. About four years ago, the League was concerned at the level of entries to its Individual Championships which were run along the lines of American Tournaments but played at clubs and homes throughout the season. The inevitable result was that games between players were not completed due to the usual apathy shown by chess players when having to arrange their own games and entries dwindled each year as more and more players became disillusioned by trying to arrange games against seemingly uninterested players. At last, the point was reached where either the championships would have to be abandoned or a new format found. In hope (or was it desperation!) the League decided to hold a weekend congress at which the Championships would be contested. The only problem was finance (or lack of it). Hiring a suitable venue for a weekend costs money. In the end, it was decided that a small entry fee should be charged to cover the hire of the room but that players would only play for the honour of winning one of the individual championships for which a magnificent trophy would be held by the winner for one year. Money prizes would only be awarded if the number of entries was sufficient to more than cover the overheads and, in fact, the winner of Section 1 the first year received the princely sum of £5. This has been the principle of the succeeding tournaments and this year's will be the fourth. Groups of around 20 players are made up with the highest 20 in Section 1 etc. This forms the basis of a very successful congress and entries have grown steadily each year with about 80 playing last November. The entrants play for honour and satisfaction rather than cash and the competitive nature of each group ensures that first round losers still have a chance of winning the Tournament. Other areas should consider holding events of this kind for which there seems to be a demand and perhaps unlike Bristol make them open to all comers.

Your remarks in Part II were obviously sent by a Controller who had not yet recovered from his previous Congress. Although, in general, I agree with his remarks, particularly the lack of understanding of Controllers' problems, I still get immense pleasure and satisfaction from the job. Of course, it is hard work and the night after a congress is pure bliss but, even so, I am always ready to do it all again next time. All those things which, at the time, seem so tragic, can retrospectively be the sources of many a humorous tale. Surely, some long-serving Controller might one day write a book on this subject which might well serve as good bedtime reading after a hard day. Even your letter writer probably has a store of pleasant memories which more than make up for all the aggravation all Controllers suffer from at times.

W.E.C.U. Hon. Grader's Report

In this Grading List we have continued our policy of not publishing the grades of unregistered players. The names of those affected by this ruling have been included in the list to indicate that their grades have been calculated and are available. The procedure to follow in order to obtain these grades and have them published is detailed in the Registration Officer's comments which follow this report.

continued

The qualifying requirements for a B.C.F. grade are: a minimum of 30 games during the last two seasons' at least 10 of which must have been played during the last season. If at least 30 games have been played during the last season, then results from the previous season are ignored when calculating the grade. In this year's list, grades calculated on one season's performance are marked with an *, B.C.F. recognised grades based on 2 seasons results are marked with a +.

Players who do not qualify for a B.C.F. grade can have a Union grade which is based on fewer results. The requirement for this is: a minimum of 18 games during the last 2 seasons, at least 8 of which must have been played during the last season. In addition to the above, our list also includes players who do not qualify for a B.C.F. or Union grade but have sufficient results for a good estimate to be made as to their playing strength, such players are indicated by a negative sign after their grade.

Certain players in our list play in other Unions (apart from Congresses) these players are indicated by the appropriate Union letter, which means that their grades are probably based on results from more than one Union. If there is anyone who thinks that he should have results from another Union and it is not indicated, would he please write to me and give details.

As is my usual practice, I list the statistics relating to this year's grades:-

Even though the end of the grading year is the 30th April, it has been my practice to include later results. In fact, this year I have included both the Stroud and Bristol Manor Tyres Congresses played in May and June respectively. This has never delayed the publication of our Grading List and we are, traditionally, the first Union to publish. I defend this attitude on the grounds that grades published at the beginning of one season should be calculated on as many games as possible from the previous season.

This coming season the BCF are experimenting with an interim grading list, to be published in mid-season, which will be based only on Congress results played between May and October. Consequently, the BCF are now "suggesting" that we, in the the WECU, should adhere to the April deadline! They feel unable to accept my counter "suggestion" that the end of the grading year should be later.

Some of you may have heard about the BCF resolution which requests certain Congresses to pay a board fee to the BCF. There has also been talk about sanctions, such as , not grading the results from Congresses who do not pay. To avoid any misunderstanding, I wish to make it absolutely clear that whatever happens I intend to continue to grade all Congresses played within the WECU, provided that they supply me with their results.

continued

For interest, last season there were over 4200 results from Congresses and the total number of results recorded in the WECU list was in excess of 58000.

I would welcome comments from anyone who has strong views on the above topics, and ask them to expound them in our Westward Ho! debating forum.

I would like to close my report by thanking all our regional graders for their magnificent support. I am sorry to say that Phil Meade of Gloucestershire is having to give up his Grading work but, in his place, I welcome back Mr. J.E. Edwards who has returned to the fold! which must prove that grading is an enjoyable occupation. I would also like to thank all the other Unions for their co-operation. In particular, the NCCU and SCCU with whom I have been able to resolve most of our cross-boundary work. Finally, I would like to thank Mr. A.J.L. Wade, our Registration Officer, who has once again undertaken the task of checking registrations with his usual speed.

NEW BOOK NEWS

IMPROVING YOUR CHESS by P.C. Griffiths

Improving Your Chess is aimed at the weaker club players who wish to develop their game. It assumes that they have learnt the basic rules for moving the pieces, the definition of Checkmate and Stalemate, and chess notation.

The first chapter deals with elementary principles, such as the importance of material and the relative value of the pieces. The later chapters illustrate a number of standard attacking techniques against the castled king and some basic principles of positional play for games where direct attacks on the king are not involved. They also show how these themes develop in the transition period between opening and middle-game, which is often a stumbling-block for many players. Finally, the end game is dealt with and the techniques for exploiting the advantages gained earlier.

P.C. Griffiths is a professional chess coach and writer. He has played in the British National Championships and is experienced at understanding the problems faced by beginners seeking to improve their game.
