

# ~~WESTWARD HO!~~

This is surely an historic edition. With the unanimous vote of all counties in the Union only registered players have a grade published, and there are bound to be those who disapprove. Well, you can't please everybody, and there are bound to be some whose grade is unpublished who have registered. There is a procedure for speedily remedying this and it is explained later in this edition.

My personal appeal to those who have not registered is please do. We need the money and if everyone registers there will be more to share the costs of chess administration. Cornwall sets us a magnificent example - 100% registration - yet Cornwall travels hundreds of miles every year to compete in events and support the Union. They do so for the good of chess - and that is what we all want to see prosper. Let us follow in their footsteps.

#### MATCH CAPTAIN'S REPORT.

Another season is now almost with us. If we look back to the 1976/77 we can do so with pride. Greatly outnumbered, heavily outgraded by the other Unions, the West did astonishingly well. Gloucester were only narrowly defeated in the semi-finals by Lancashire (11-9) and Lancashire in the finals beat Yorkshire. In the Minor Counties Devon II only lost to Middlesex II in the semi-finals - and Middlesex only lost to Yorkshire in the finals by  $10\frac{1}{2}$ - $9\frac{1}{2}$ . A truly great performance for the Western Union and an answer to those critics who look down on the chess prowess of the West. The next shock to the chess world may well be provided by our juniors, for we certainly have some remarkably strong youngsters coming along.

The Union Jamboree is fixed for Saturday, 1st October, and entries must be received by me not later than 14th September. In the Graded Jamboree the grading limit is 130 and below. This is on 1976 grades and NOT on the grades published in this issue. The Venue for this year is at the Rougemont Hotel, Exeter, and NOT at Exeter University.

For the guidance of Match Captains I set out below the requirements for the following season:-

1. All Counties are requested to send me a list of the 14 first team players who are ineligible to play in the Minor Counties Championship not later than 7 days before the opening County Matches on October 22nd.
2. All results and board fees to be sent to me as soon as possible after the completion of each match.
3. The grades of the players to be put beside their names.
4. Results of adjudications to be sent to me as soon as they are known. (Failure to do this may well penalise a player whose game would not be graded.)

#### SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT.

Westward Ho! has an increasingly wide circulation and is making the following offer to all Congress Organisers. With each issue we are prepared to enclose Congress entry forms provided the Congress subscribes to Westward Ho! for one year (cost £1.50). LETTERS TO THE EDITOR.

Dear Sir,

In response to our Editor's article "Grading and all that -- ", I would like to spell out the situation as I see it.

Leaving aside the adjudication of games, which I see as a separate issue, the various types of games played to a finish can be categorised into five groups, namely:

1. Correspondence games.
2. Games played at a uniform rate of play.
3. Games played at differing rates of play.
4. Games played in which the latter stages are 'sudden death'
5. Quick play and Lightning games.

Until now we have only accepted games from groups 2 and 3 for grading provided that the rate of play has not exceeded 30 moves per hour.

It has never been suggested that our grades should include the results of Correspondence games, this is considered logical as certain of the rules for these games differ from the rules for 'over the board'. Also the British Correspondence Chess Association does produce its own Grading List for these players.

But is it not true that different rules apply to the last two groups, (e.g. the capture of the King), if the differences are ignored and it is accepted that one should grade games from groups 2, 3, 4, and 5, can be graded, who debar Correspondence games? It would then be immaterial to the Grader whether clocks were used or not, he just grades everything!

So as I see it, we only have to decide whether we accept the current restrictions or grade everything. The choice is yours. As in spite of any impression to the contrary given by our Editor we are still a democratic organisation.

Dear Sir,

Your recent article on grading certainly should give many players some food for thought. The present system certainly needs a clearer definition of "gradeable games". Certainly games played to a finish are the best indication of relative strength of players but we are all aware of the difficulties of arranging this on all occasions. Even at the Hexagon Congress whose praises you so rightly sing, I have seen a strong player resign after a few moves in the last round game against a weaker player as his opponent would not 'agree' a draw and he wanted to go home early as he had no chance of a prize. Was this game indicative of the players strength? Yet it was presumably sent for grading! Also with many leagues playing most matches in the evenings, time is necessarily at a premium and some artificial way of deciding the game has to be used. Why is it that games between 2 players are treated in different ways depending on the form this finish takes. If adjudication is used involving a much stronger player than the participants, when the games are graded, but if

the players themselves are allowed to complete play in a so called quick time finish then this is not allowable for grading in the WECU.

I am chief controller for Chess National Promotions who for Chess National Promotions who have consistently used the quick time finishes and the big majority of games completed using this method have exactly the same result as would arise from normal play or adjudications. Many of the players have asked me why the WECU does not grade their games, particularly as those who feel they cannot cope with this type of chess are not obliged to enter, any more than other players who dislike adjudication are obliged to play games with that kind of finish. Incidentally, I feel that your interpretation of sudden death finishes is misleading. All congresses that I have attended allow players the use of all time saved before the time control as well as the additional time for the quick finish. A quick mover could therefore have a considerable time for the last part of the game. Also as controller I have had many handicapped players in the competitions and always make a point of asking if they desire a person to be appointed to operate their clock in timed finishes.

As a Union we have quite rightly declared war on non payers of registration fees but as grading is the inducement being offered surely as many games as possible should be included. Chess National Promotions and its congress participants are the major victims of the present system. So often we are told of the way in which congresses and their organisers do not put anything into chess and are parasites living on the back of the considerable voluntary work given to the Counties, Unions, and BCF. To put the record straight I would like to list a few of the things which Chess National Promotions have done for British Chess in the past two seasons:

- (a) Provided free facilities and accomodation for both competitors for the BCF Ladies Championship play off.
- (b) Provided free facilities for the recent Gloucestershire v Lancashire Semi-Final match in the English Counties Championship and allowed players who were playing in the congress to play for either county if required, although this would have meant rearranging games.
- (c) Similar for Middlesex v Herts match earlier this year.
- (d) Provided many free places for juniors to play in events as well as subsidising others who had been entered by the Manager of the National Junior Training Squads (L.W.Barden).

Surely there is as much a case for grading quick time games as for non grading of adjudicated games. Also would all graders be prepared to gurantee that all games sent to them are played with clocks. I am certain that many games played without clocks are graded each year and this must be another area which can be looked at.

Finally may I congratulate you on setting up the Westward Ho! Correspondence event but I am a little surprised that you are unaware that the BCCA which is the biggest chess correspondence club in Britain have their own grading list which this season includes 389 names.

On your rule 1 for games eligible for grading in tournaments using quick-play endings, I would suggest the following definition:

"A game shall be eligible for grading provided it is played to a required speed of not more than 30 moves per hour during all or any part of its duration". I don't like your 40 moves per hour, even for part of a game.

W.E.C.U. Hon. Grader's Report

As was agreed at our Council Meeting last year, we have omitted the grades of all unregistered players. The names of those affected by this ruling have been included in the list, to show that their grades have been calculated and are available. The procedure to follow in order to obtain these grades and have them published is detailed in the Registration Officer's comments which follow this report.

In my usual Regional analysis of this list, I have included the details of those unregistered. It is here that we must take our hats off to Cornwall who have registered every one of their graded players. The remaining figures I leave to speak for themselves, apart from mentioning that there was one player whose name had to be left out of the Union list which is published in the B.C.F. Year Book because he was unregistered!

The qualifying requirements for a B.C.F. grade is: a minimum of 30 games during the last two seasons, at least 10 of which must have been played during the last season. Of the players in this list 927 so qualify, the remainder have either, half the B.C.F. requirements, or have played at least 10 games during the last season.

Certain players in our list play in other Unions (apart from Congresses), these players are indicated by the appropriate Union letter, which means that their grade most probably contains results from more than one Union. If there is anyone who thinks he should have results from another Union and it is not indicated, would he please write to me giving details.

I would like to close my report by thanking a number of dedicated people, without whose help this list would not be possible. Firstly our own area Graders who continue to supply me with results of their labours well before my deadlines. Here I would particularly mention Mr E.C. Sowden who is the retiring Grader for Wiltshire, and Mr D.P. Bonner who is giving up the Somerset grading after many years in the post. Secondly my thoughts go to the other Union Graders, the co-operation between the Union's is excellent, and we have attempted to minimise the anomalies between our lists. Next, my thanks to Mr A.J.L. Wade our Registration Officer, who this year had the added task of checking my list to ascertain which players were registered. There were those who thought that this task was too onerous, just to confound those people Mr Wade carried out this check virtually by return of post! And finally but by no means least, my sincere thanks to Mr G.W. Kilmister for producing this list with his customary speed and accuracy.

COMMENTS OF THE REGISTRATION OFFICER

A "U" against a player's name indicates that, as at the 1st July, 1977, he or she was not currently registered according to my records and so no grade has been published.

There may be some errors in those records. I have had to cope with badly written Registration forms, misspelt names and wrong initials. Where possible I have made the necessary corrections, but obviously there may be many more regarding which I have no knowledge.

If you consider that an error has been made by a "U" being placed against your name, take the following action. Approach the person responsible for your registration (Club Secretary etc.) and obtain his or her confirmation that in fact the registration fees were passed forward. Then write to me stating the name and official position of the person concerned and the name(s) of your club(s). I will investigate and when satisfied will advise you of your grading and will arrange for it to be published in the next issue of Westward Ho.

Should you, although unregistered, require your Grading, you may obtain it by writing to me enclosing a cheque for £1.25 to cover late registration and administrative expenses. If Club Secretaries require the Gradings for several of their unregistered players then please note the charge is £1.25 per player concerned. Cheques should be made payable to:- West of England Chess Union.
