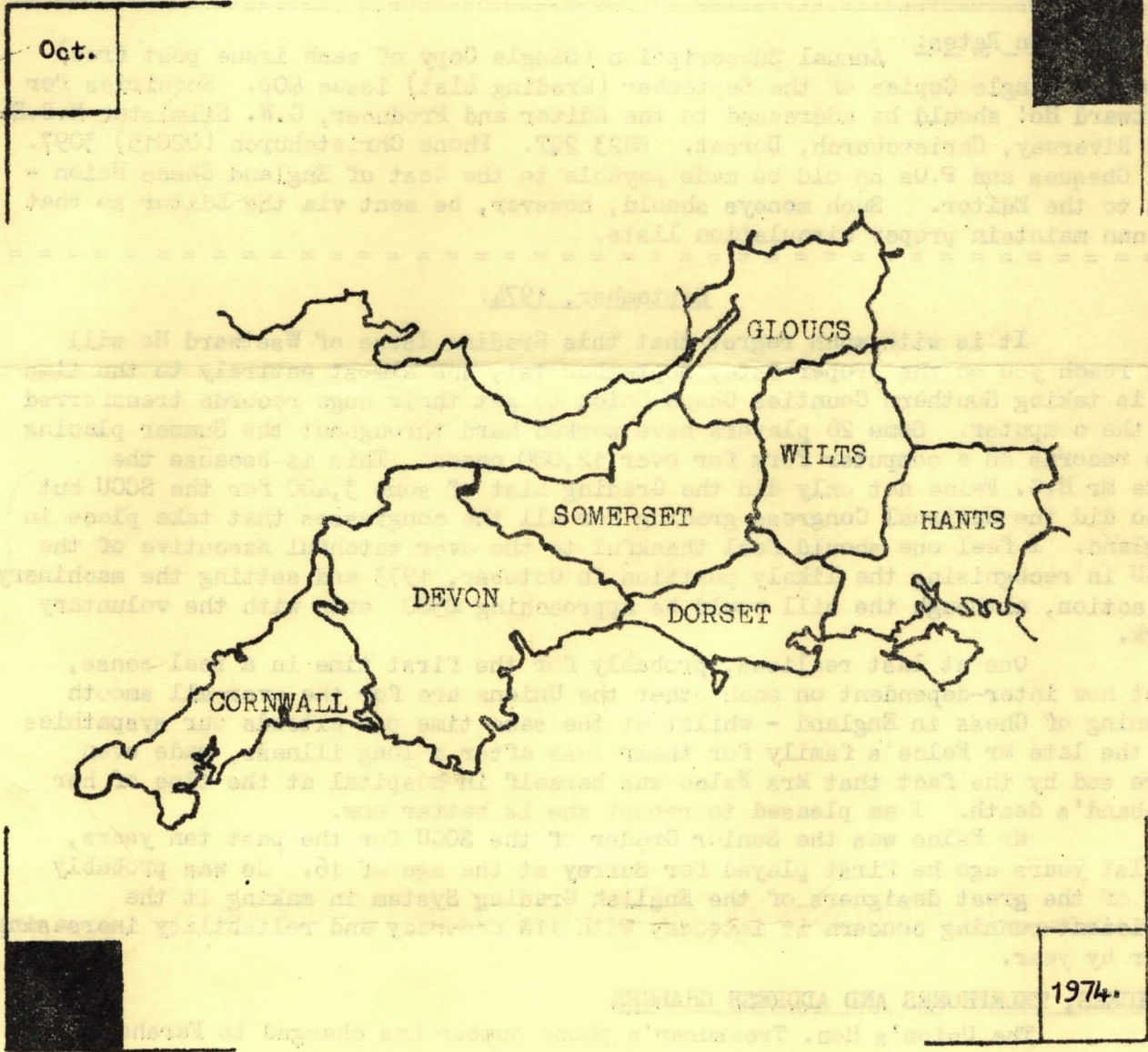

It is with much regret that this Grading Issue of Westward Ho will not reach you on the proper date, September 1st, due almost entirely to the time it is taking Southern Counties Chess Union to get their huge records transferred to the computer. Some 26 players have worked hard throughout the Summer placing the records on a computer form for over 12,000 names. This is because the late Mr H.G. Felce not only did the Grading List of some 3,400 for the SCCU but also did the National Congress grading for all the congresses that take place in England. I feel one should feel thankful to the ever watchful Executive of the SCCU in recognising the likely position in October, 1973 and setting the machinery in action, although the bill could be approaching £500 even with the voluntary work.

One at last realises, probably for the first time in a real sense, just how inter-dependent on each other the Unions are for the over-all smooth running of Chess in England - whilst at the same time one extends our sympathies to the late Mr Felce's family for their loss after a long illness, made even more sad by the fact that Mrs Felce was herself in hospital at the time of her husband's death. I am pleased to report she is better now.

Mr Felce was the Senior Grader of the SCCU for the past ten years, whilst years ago he first played for Surrey at the age of 16. He was probably one of the great designers of the English Grading System in making it the efficient-running concern it is today with its accuracy and reliability increasing year by year.

OUR PRESIDENT

It is with pleasure that I am able to report that the Union's President, Mr A.W. Busby, continues to progress well if slowly and all will join with me in wishing him continued and the speediest possible progress. It was indeed nice to see him again at the Union's Executive Meeting on Sept 14th last.

The match between Korchnoi and Karpov for the right to challenge the World Champion, Fischer, will be starting about the time you receive this Bulletin and Fischer has been given until the end of January, 1975, to decide whether he accepts the I.C.F. terms of play, or his resignation is automatically accepted if he does not give agreement by then. Whilst it will be sad if the winner of the Challenger's match gets the title without having to win it properly in battle over the Chess Board, I fear there is little more can be expected.

Like all other publications it is correct to give our Congratulations to A.J. (Tony) Miles for winning the Under-23 World Championship title, beating even the Russian nomination on the way. With J. Mestel winning the World Cadet Title earlier in the year, England now holds two world titles and surely this is real tribute to the activities of the B.C.F., the Friends of Chess and Mr Slater in providing the possibilities of training, etc. One can even go further with D.S.C. Goodman achieving 2nd place just behind the Russian Winner in the European Junior Championships. Added to these are the good performances of J. Speelman and Paul Littlewood whilst there is a number of others sitting close behind from the age of 13 upwards.

Going still further, at the last Olympiad R.D. Keene obtained his first norm towards a Grandmaster title and one is a little sorry to see the press remarks at the time because no complaint was ever made to this country's proper authority.

THE BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIPS

Played at Clacton-on-Sea in August, the Championship resulted after 11 rounds in a seven way tie with a score of 7/11 - not a good performance for one who would, one expects, win the British Title in a play-off. One is left to speculate whether the effect of the Cutty Sark English Scotch Whiskey Grand Prix had much effect on this result by certain games being played with the primary view of getting at least a half-point instead of an all-out death or glory. Again one might even question the fairness of a play-off in easy conditions as against winning the title in the Open Congress conditions with its distractions however good the control is. However, there is one bright spot for from all sides, I have heard nothing but praise for Dr Shilton and his Control Team this year. Somehow I feel this is the first priority to get right, then all else will have a chance of following in good time.

From this Union's view-point it was not a good Championship with N.J. Holloway alone exceeding 50% score, whilst that most seasoned campaigned with several 2nd place finishes, P.H. Clarke and G.H. Bennett scored only 4½/11

This, once again, was an easy time for Mrs Hartston, finishing 1½ points ahead of the field. However both Miss Caldwell and Miss Jackson did well to draw with the Champion and one feels special praise must go to Mrs M.E.E. Clarke, with 8/11 - despite the trials of two young children now, she is fast regaining the command which brought her the British Girls Title several times in past years. Results:-

The Union's Grader, Mr F.C. Kingdon, reports as follows:-

"I am glad to be able to report that the Grading Figures from the S.C.C.U. are now to hand and that we have been able to complete our calculation of the grades for this List.

Once again more players are included in the List, all regions having contributed to this increase. The fact that the total number of Hampshire players has decreased is as a result of the county boundary re-organisation, whereby all Bournemouth and Christchurch players are dealt with by Dorset Graders.

The position of Westward Ho in relation to the delay in issuing the Southern Counties Grading Figures was discussed and it was decided that Westward Ho should publish with, or without, these figures on Oct 7th, the posting being done on Oct 5th.

It was decided that there was not enough time to hold the B.C.F. Championships in the West Area for 1976 but it was agreed that the Union should accept the offer to hold these Championships at Cheltenham in 1979 and Dr J.M. Aitken, one of the Union's Life Vice-Presidents, was to be asked to take charge of matters in the Cheltenham Area for this event.

The date of the Junior Jamboree was brought forward from March 8th to Feb 22nd to give time for any adjudications to be judged so that entries could be got in at the proper time for the B.C.F. Junior Jamboree Championships.

The next WECU Congress will be at Weymouth next Easter.

A Presentation was made to Mr Jack Beard in appreciation for his services for 20 years as Treasurer of the Association.

Bennett (who defaulted in the first round because he could not make the start after playing in a weekend event), P.C. Griffiths and M.A. Stevenson with $5\frac{1}{2}$. Dr Aitken, M.J. Staples and C. Cooley each scored 3 points. J.C. Cock of Cheltenham and J.B. Goodman of Plymouth scored 2. W.H. Pratten of Portsmouth $1\frac{1}{2}$. (Omission: R.M. The late arrival of G.H. Bennett sets the Chief Controller with a very difficult problem of giving such a strong player an easy passage through starting round 2 on Zero points by defaulting him for being over an hour late at the board, or allowing him to start his first round late. I hope this will set a standard practice that all players should start equally at the same time, or with 'Cutty Sark' type tournaments, one could in future get several rounds missed, which would ruin Swiss draws.
