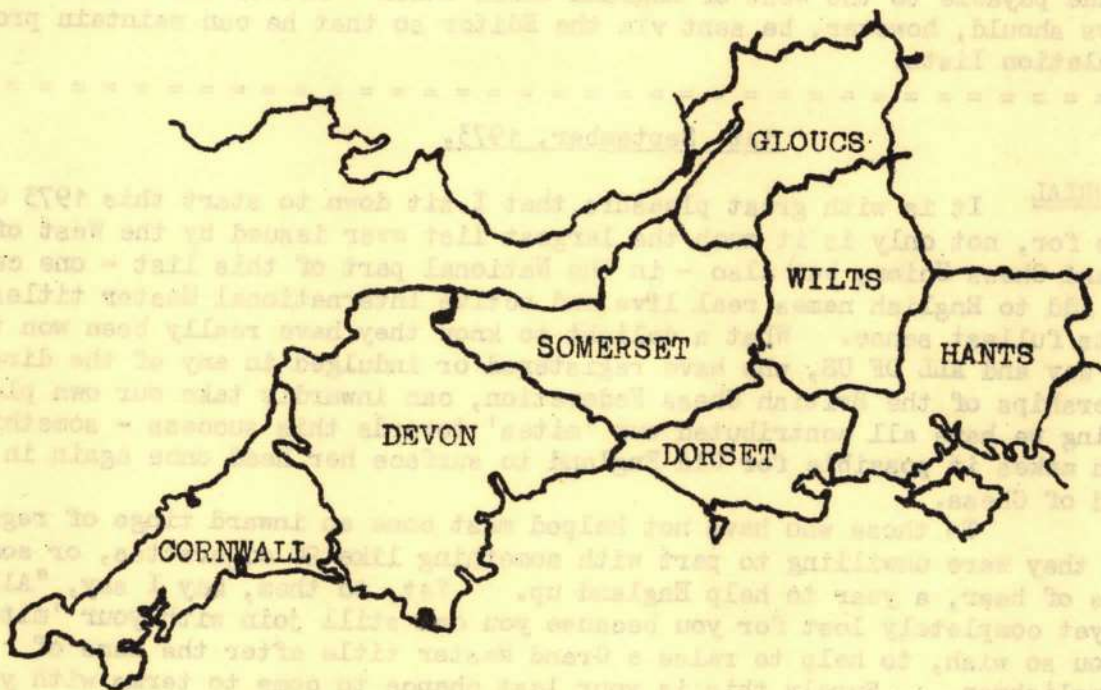

Once again we have a significant increase in the number of Players included in the Grading List. Many of these are because of the increased number of junior results graded in Hampshire and the active Association in North Devon, but all regions have included more Players this season.

This is a tribute to the hard work of your regional Grading Officers.

As is our custom, those players whose performances are recognised by the B.C.F., are marked with an asterisk, and those, who, according to my records, will be under 18 on 1st September, 1973 are marked with the letter 'J' after their grade figure.

To obtain the asterisk mentioned above it is necessary to have played at least 30 graded games during the last two seasons and at least ten of these must have been in the current season. Because this requirement would exclude many West of England players, we relax this requirement to either half the above number of games, or to players who have ten games in the current season; and those players who meet either of these requirements are shown without an asterisk.

We have this season given separately the List of Players who will be in the National List; as will be seen there are five West of England players included, namely Messrs P.H. Clarke, N.J. Holloway, S.J. Hutchings, D.J. Walsh and P. Waters, our congratulations to them all.

Also this season we have listed in Grade Order the 40 West of England players who are graded at 185, or above.

I would like to thank all the Area Graders for their support and help throughout the season; I am sorry to say that Mr Barnes, North Gloucestershire, is retiring from these duties.

GENERAL NEWS:

Whilst some will have seen these items elsewhere, others will like knowing if they have missed it.

CLARE BENEDICT TEAM TOURNAMENT AT GSTAAD.

The 20th Tournament was played at the Palace Hotel, Gstaad towards the end of June. England's Team of Hartston, Keene, Penrose, Markland and Whiteley finished 2nd on games score and a point behind West Germany. 8 Countries took part and the final scores were:- West Germany  $17\frac{1}{2}$  Pts, England  $16\frac{1}{2}$ , Denmark  $16\frac{1}{2}$ , Holland  $14\frac{1}{2}$ , Spain 14, Austria  $13\frac{1}{2}$ , Switzerland 11 and Italy  $8\frac{1}{2}$ .

It is interesting to note that Hartston drew all his games on board 1 and both Keene (+3-4-0) and Penrose (+1-5-0) did not lose a game, but Markland and Whiteley both lost only 1 game. The English Team did not lose a single one of the 7 matches, but could only draw against Denmark, Holland and Spain. R.D. Keene won the prize for the highest score over-all.

WORLD OPEN AT NEW YORK

Thanks to sponsorship by the "Evening Standard, The Guardian, Robert Silk Fellowship and the 'Friends of Chess', Simon Webb, Robert Bellin and A.J. Mestel were able to play in this large American Tournament with a \$15,000 prize fund. These three English players did exceedingly well against the New World Continent Grandmasters and International Masters, both R. Bellin and S. Webb finishing equal 3rd behind W.S. Browne G.M. and J. Kaplan I.M. and ahead of several other G.Ms and I.Ms. A.J. Mestel finished 6th. Final scores were W.S. Browne 9/10, J. Kaplan  $8\frac{1}{2}/10$ , Bellin and Webb 8/10 and Mestel  $7\frac{1}{2}/10$ .

BATH'S EUROPEAN TEAM TOURNAMENT

As part of this year's celebrations of the crowning of the first King of All England in Bath 1,000 years ago, Bath kindly housed the European Team Tournament which England had won a place in by virtue of beating Holland last Summer.

England's team was made up from Hartston, Keene, Penrose, Markland, Whiteley, Botterill, Wade, Stean, Miles and Eley and at the end of a week's play, they finished in 6th position against the strongest teams that European Countries could produce.

The final results were U.S.S.R.  $40\frac{1}{2}$  pts, Yugoslavia 34, Hungary 33, Poland 25, West Germany 24, England 24, Rumania 23 and Switzerland  $20\frac{1}{2}$ . England came below West Germany because that country beat us in our individual match, and broadly speaking England achieved what was expected of them. The one sad part was the failure to appreciate the vast interest Europe's top Chess Masters could attract in visitors and many visitors were disappointed, even ticket holders!

In all previous four occasions that this tournament has been staged since 1957, it has always been won by the U.S.S.R. with almost overwhelming leads over all other teams. Their win this time is only by  $6\frac{1}{2}$  points, the smallest to date.

Once again, Hartston, playing top board, went through this Tournament without losing a game - in fact drawing all seven games against the leaders of the other 7 countries. Keene, Botterill, Stean and Eley all achieved 50% scores, a young selection which brings much hope for the future.

COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIP

This is probably the one sad climax of an otherwise good Summer for Essex were awarded the title by default - unthinkable but true. The finals date was officially 7th July, clashing with Bath. This meant Cambridge would be missing three of their top players and despite the assurance of the Essex Match Captain that Essex would be without three of their top boards, one at Bath, Cambridge said it was unpractical to produce a team on the date and no other mutually agreeable date could be found, so Essex, who were prepared to field a team on July 7th, were awarded the title by default.

WORLD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:

These World Championships were housed at the Thornaby Pavilion by the Teeside Corporation with the approval of the B.C.F. 50 competitors entered, including A.J. Miles and M.F. Stean of England, from 48 countries. It was decided to split the contestants into 4 groups, A,B,C, & D - A being the Championship Group and preliminary play was to decide who went into which group. FIRST HOLSWORTHY SPEED CHAMPIONSHIP

This was played at Holsworthy at the weekend following the conclusion of the Bath European Team Tournament, 41 players taking part.

The winner was G.W. Wheeler of Plymouth with a full-house score of 9/9. B. Eley, the reigning British Champion at the time, was second with  $7\frac{1}{2}$  and equal with him was P.H. Clarke, but it was pointed out that probably both these players were somewhat exhausted after Bath. D.K. Butler, Royal Navy Champion, was third with  $6\frac{1}{2}$ . Mrs M.E.E. Clarke controlled this Lightning Tournament.

SUNDAY TIMES NATIONAL SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIP.

After Manchester Grammar School had beaten Bristol Grammar in the Quarter-finals, Manchester Grammar withdrew from the competition. Bristol Grammar was re-instated and was one of the four teams to go to the Ermin Hotel, London for the Semi-finals and final. Glyn Grammar School lost to Bolton School 4-1 in the Semi-finals and Latymer School beat Bristol Grammar by 3 to 2. Bolton went on to win the final by beating Latymer by 4 to 2.

In the play off for 3rd and 4th places, Bristol Grammar beat Glyn Grammar 4-1, thereby winning 3rd place. Once again Bristol Schools are to be congratulated in getting so far before being knocked out.

" WHY SHOULD WE ? "

"Why should we pay the exorbitant sum of 25p a year each into the coffers of the British Chess Federation? Who are they, anyway? And what do they do for us?"

Indeed, what does the B.C.F. do for you, the 'ordinary' club player? Some of you may already be members of the Federation, either direct (i.e. Full or Associate Members, or Vice Presidents) or registered (via your club or County). If the latter, you may well have paid up reluctantly. I should like to state the B.C.F.'s case.

We need your money because otherwise there is little cash to fund a central organisation. Why does British chess NEED a central organisation? If there is no British Chess Federation, to whom will people turn to ask about, for example, Tournament Rules, the Swiss System, their nearest chess club, women's chess, correspondence chess, how to start a chess club, where to find a chess-master for a simultaneous, the existence of weekend congresses, where their infant prodigies can be taught the game, and so on, and so on? Admittedly, any one person could probably deal with two or three of these queries, but there is a need for a central organisation able to offer help and advice to all comers. Because, if there isn't a need, why is my daily post generally in excess of 30 letters and why do my incoming telephone calls leave me little time to deal with the post?

(By the bye, we also organise the British Championships, the Counties Championships, the National Club Championship, the British Open Lightning Championships, we send (to the best of our ability and to the extent our budget allows) teams and players to represent Britain in International Events, we publish annually The Year Book and monthly, a magazine, News Flash, and we also provide, among other services, a National Grading Scheme.)

To be registered, which involves paying 25p p.a. to the B.C.F., is mandatory if you take part in certain events. You can play an awful lot of chess without having to be registered. But if every chessplayer paid his or her registration fee voluntarily to this lumbering, inefficient, unloved, 'umbrella' of British chess, maybe the Federation would be able to lurch out of its Dark Ages and become more efficient and provide a better service to all chess players and would-be chess players.

How about it?

TELEPHONE CHESS

I have been trying to find out details of how this can be achieved and I understand that so far as the Telephone Authorities are concerned, it is necessary for one of the officials of the League, Team, Club or what have you playing, to book a CONTRACT LINK with your local exchange between 2 numbers for a specific continuous period.

In each case it is better to have the phone in a room immediately adjacent to the playing hall and a clear-speaking chess knowledgeable person on the phone who knows the Phone Rules in the B.C.F. Year Book, 71/72, page 56.

The total cost for Contract Links OVER 50 miles apart is £1.80 per hour multiplied by the number of hours play is for. Divide the resultant figure in half and that will be the cost to each team IF PLAY STARTS AFTER 6 pm. Thus for 3½ hours play, cost to each team would be £3.15 - the cost to each individual player being the number of players divided into £3.15 - it being born in mind that if there is over 8 a side, slightly longer time must be booked for phone delays in passing moves. Even so, this would be a fraction of the cost of players travelling from Gloucester, Hampshire or Cornwall to say Exeter. Further players would NOT have a tiring journey before play, only to somewhere central in Bristol, Southampton or Truro or Redruth.

Assume a county match by phone of Central Cornwall to Central Hampshire - Truro - Southampton, starting at 3 PM Saturday and play over 4 hours on 16 boards, then the cost would be £6 a team, some 38p phone cost per player - far less than travel costs, fewer defaults and a good chance of producing a last minute replacement.

One big query? Does it infringe County Championship rules. I do not know the rules well enough to pronounce with certainty but I believe it was used once in the B.C.F. Counties Championship section. Can anybody answer positively?

ELO/INTERNATIONAL CHESS FEDERATION RATING SYSTEM

Many players will know of the famous Elo International Rating System based on graded Congress play. I believe many would like to know that Mr B.H. Wood's Chess (Chess Sutton Coldfield B73 6AZ England) started in its July issue a four part explanation of this system by Professor Arpad E. Elo himself - thereby making the July, August, September and October issues of this magazine of particular interest in supplying really authoritative information on the Rating System which has been adopted by F.I.D.E. etc, as I understand it.

At one time one would have questioned its working in England because much English Chess is of Club, League and County levels. However, today, with the ever increasing number of Congresses of all types, there would appear to be a fast appearing case for Elo Rating in conjunction with at least our own Grading System, which really works well for the English type of Chess played in the past.

CHESS CLOCKS

Has any player or Club a broken GARDE Chess Clock. If so your Editor has half such a clock in good working order and would either like to acquire broken clocks to make into good ones, or will use his parts to make your clock good. Sadly the firm which made these clocks went out of business, so that it is impossible to buy spare parts on the market.

The new Russian Chess Clock, advertised in Chess, has a strong movement mechanically, a pleasing appearance and a semi-hard plastic case in white which will withstand shocks without breaking. The stop-start mechanism is probably one of the most efficient types but watch that the flag falls at the hour. It is only a small job to adjust this, some new clocks' flags showing a tendency for the fall of the flag to be a little early in relation to the position of the minute hand and the clock face. If, however, the clock is started with the flag just up, then it falls on the hour with the minute hand having done a complete revolution.
