B.C.F. Shield

This year, the award has been made to St. John's College, Southsea.

When it is considered that the Southern Counties comprise Beds., Berks, Bucks., Cambs., Essex, Hants., Herts., Kent, Middlesex, Norfolk, Oxfordshire, Suffolk, Surrey and Sussex, this is seen to be a considerable honour.

Previous awards to Hampshire have been Taunton's School Southampton (1926) and King Edward 6th, Southampton (1955).

All local players will be delighted that the efforts of Bro. Charles to teach a great number of boys over a good number of years the right way to play Chess has received a very fitting reward.
