Messrs. Crewe and Russell have been co-opted onto the new Committee, which will therefore comprise these two names plus Messrs. Parsons, Grant, Garner, Barton and Eaton.

Quite frankly, I was disappointed with the A.G.M. itself. Apart from the Committee, the Individual Conductor and the chap who came along to claim his Individual Championship Trophy, there were only 7 members present. Of the 2 hours available, some $1\frac{3}{4}$ hours were taken up in rather useless recrimination over what should have been done last season, leaving practically no time at all to discuss how it might be done better next season.

In fact the only bit of constructive business carried out was the passing of the following resolution which clarifies the position regarding the payment of Junior Fares:-

- a) That refunds of a proportion of expenses incurred by Juniors in travelling to County Matches be in future restricted to those Juniors who have not reached their 18th birthday on the 1st. September previous and are not in receipt of a regular income from a personal occupation.
- b) That expenses for this purpose shall be taken to mean Bus Fares and/or Second Class Train Fares only (it being understood that full advantage is to be taken of cheap day excursion rates).
- (c) That the proportion of such expenses that be refunded by the Association shall continue to be 50%.
- d) That application for a refund of such expenses shall be made on the proper form, which will be issued by the Match Captain to those players who appear to him to qualify for refunds, and which will be countersigned by him.

MATCH RESULTS

A new feature introduced at the end of last season was a 'Juniors v Seniors' Match. This seems a good idea and one which is worth continuing.

Pity that there were such a lot of defaults - perhaps the end of May is too late for such matches.
