## Hampshire Championship Tournament

On previous occasions the Individual Champion of Hampshire has been determined by a seven round Swiss tournament, and although this has invariably produced a worthy champion, the drawbacks of this form of competition (time element, travel and expense) have deterred many strong players from entering. In an effort to run a really strong tournament, pre-season committee-opinion favoured a weekend event with a restricted entry comprising of the past champion, League champions and a few nominated players from the outlying districts. This suggestion met with strong resistance, since it automatically excluded most of the top board players of the County team and as the winner and runner-up from the proposed tournament were to be awarded a bonus of playing respectively boards one and two, then the general demand was for an open tournament.

The resulting tournament, played at Eastleigh during the weekend of the 10/12 December, was a moderate success, mainly occasioned by a relative lack of support (!) since only 14 players participated, but apart from this the organisation and controlling by Mr.L.E.Vine ensured a very efficient championship. One round was played on Friday evening, with two rounds on the Saturday and the Sunday, and the rate of play was 48 moves in 2½ hours. (This was to enable games to be played to a finish. Only one drawn game had to be adjudicated!)

The Champion of Hampshire was M.J.Dymond (Gosport) with a score of 4 points (undefeated), and the runner-up was G. Daw (Bramtoco) who had a superior sum of opponents' score over R.A.Collins (University, both with 3½ points. The remainder of the table was 3 points: J.E.Crewe (Bournemouth); 2½ points: P.J.Dodwell (Bournemouth), A.M.Edmonds, J.R.Wilkinson (Itchen), A.C.Barton, G.L.Pritchard (Southampton); 2 points: G.R.Bennett (Bournemouth), T.J.DeBuriatte (Fareham), P.L.Marshall (Southampton), A.S.LaLond (Waterlooville); ½ point: D.Wright (University).

At the time of publishing, the two most important games from this tournament are not to hand. These games - Dymond v. Edmonds, and Daw v. Collins, will be included in the next bulletin.
