The passing of Mr. Sidney Lucas at the age of 77 after a short illness has removed an unforgettable personality from the Bournemouth scene

Retiring from clerical work at the G.P.O. headquarters in London, Mr. Lucas moved to Bournemouth to find himself working harder than ever as Secretary of the Bournemouth and District League from 1958 to 1966, and Chess Columnist for the Bournemouth Evening Echo. His wife frequently commented that if Mr. Lucas had worked as hard at work as he did for Chess he would have become Postmaster General.

His playing record brought rewards too. At Weymouth in 1961 he won an All-play-all in the West of England Congress, and at the age of 75 he came equal first in the Dorset Congress Reserves Championship.

One felt that with Mr. Lucas, Chess was not the serious game that one generally expects it to be, and it was rare to see a week go by without hearing him relate the funny side of a Bournemouth League incident. His friendship will be missed and his absence felt, particularly at his favourite match, Bournemouth League against Southampton League, where his tall figure was always to be seen.

Mr. J. P. Price died after a very short illness, which was a shock to his many Chess playing friends, as indeed, it must have been to his family.

He was Hon. Secretary of the Portsmouth Chess Club for a good many years - a job he did with quiet efficiency - yet he still found the energy to play some strong local Club Chess and to turn out for his County when asked to do so. A Dental Surgeon by profession, he practised in Southsea for many years.

So passes yet another of that rare breed, those willing to serve other Chess players in the Administrative field with no thought of reward but to help others to enjoy their Chess to the best of their ability.
