MATCH CAPTAIN'S REPORT

From the point of view of results the season had not been a very satisfactory one.

In the S.C.C.U. Championship we beat Bucks., drew with Berks., and lost against Surrey, Sussex and Oxford.

In the Amboyna Shield we lost to Kent, Surrey, Sussex, Berks, and Middlesex, but won against Bucks.

Hampshire were transferred from Group C to Group B in the Handicap, so that all matches qualifying for the Montague Jones Cup, except that against Kent, were lost. The Friendly v Dorset which gives a chance for more Bournemouth players to get a game for the county, was won.

The disturbing feature of the season, was the reluctance of a number of our younger players to accept the Match Captain's decision either of team selection or board order. In two cases this made it necessary to bring in reserves, or the games would have been lost by default, which I consider an insult to their opponents.

A cricket captain expects his players to accept his batting order, bowling changes, and field placings, even if they do not agree with them.

A Bowls skip expects his rink to follow his instructions, even if their ideas do not concur with his.

It seems as if one of the worst features of Soccer, of not being able to accept the Referee's decision (be it right or wrong) is creeping into our County Chess, but I hope there will be no repetition of this tendency either next season or in the foreseeable future.

Our thanks are due to those who have loyally supported the County, that is, the vast majority.
