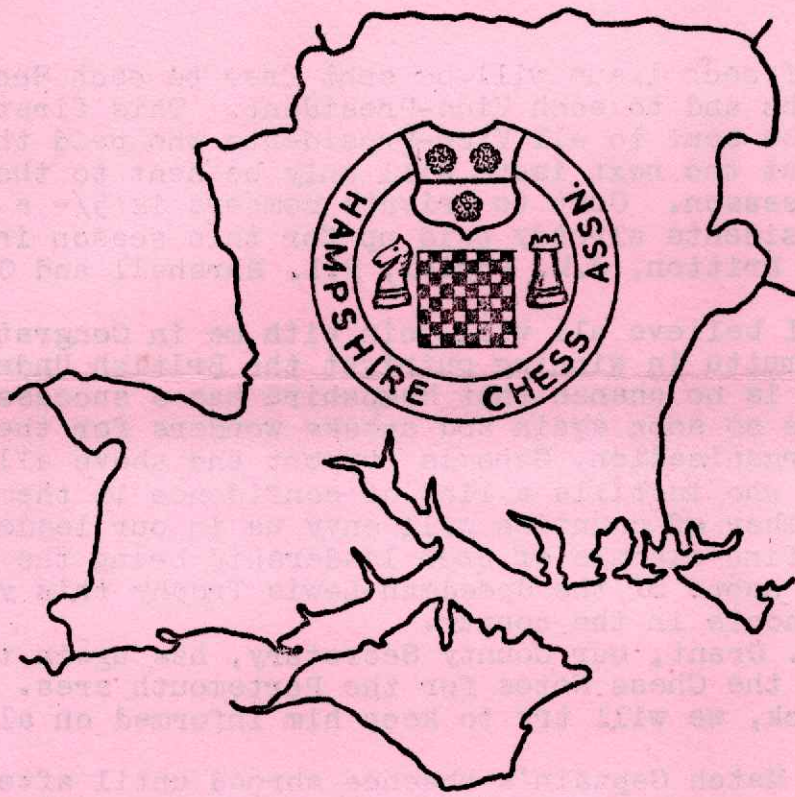

PUBLICATION

CIRCULATION

A copy of each issue will be sent free to each Secretary of Affiliated Clubs and to each Vice-President. This first issue this season will be sent to all Vice-Presidents who paid their 15/- last year, but the next issue will only be sent to those paid-up for this season. Cost to Private Members is 5/- a season.

Vice-Presidents already paid up for this season include L.G. Machon, G.P. Britton, J.M. Popiel, P.L. Marshall and G.W. Kilmister.

Firstly I believe all will join with me in Congratulating Miss Manel Saverymuttu in winning outright the British Under 18 Girl's Title. It is no chance that Hampshire has a successor to Miss Gillian Moore so soon again and speaks wonders for the County's Junior Organisation, Schools support and above all to our Match Captain who instills a line of confidence in them in match play. A number of counties will envy us in our leaders in this field, a fine example of such leadership being the broadening of the scope of the Speedman-Lewis Trophy this year to embrace all schools in the county.

Mr J.E.C. Grant, our County Secretary, has again taken on the writing of the Chess Notes for the Portsmouth area. In wishing him luck, we will try to keep him informed on all points we can.

With our Match Captain's absence abroad until after the middle of September, I agreed to issue the Match Captain's Circular Letter, Fixture dates and their return replies on availability, advice concerning the County Individual Swiss Championship Tournament and Correspondence Chess. 110 such letters were sent out on Sept 6th and yet, on Sept 25th, there have been no reply to 48 of these letters. Such delays obviously makes team raising extremely difficult, so please help your Match Captain by replying promptly, even if it only to say 'I cannot accept with certainty' or NO - so that he knows where he stands. Thank you.

With the strict B.C.F. regulations this year on Registration, I hope all who play for the County will make a point of Registering through their Club, or Direct to our County Secretary before the end of October - or we shall be penalised badly in lost games. Registration costs 6/- via your Club, 10/- direct to Mr Grant, or if you want this Bulletin, pay 15/-, be a Vice-President and get a free copy. Persons not registered as Vice-Presidents can obtain a copy by paying 5/- for the season's issues, post free.

In both cases, the County did not do so well this last season as that before - this applies especially to the "Brown-Pond" Division III. Lancashire won the Division I "Ward-Higgs" Trophy with 22 points and Surrey were second with $17\frac{1}{2}$ pts. The Sinclair Trophy was won by Warwickshire with 21 points and Lancashire second with $19\frac{1}{2}$ pts. The "Brown-Pond" Trophy was won by Lincolnshire with $14\frac{1}{2}$ points and Bedfordshire was second with 13 pts.

The best Correspondence Game Prize went to J.R. Boyce of Gloucestershire.

The Conductor for the past 20 years, Mr D.H. Butler, has retired and all will thank him for what he had done for us.

BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIPS RESULTS AT BRISTOL

It is with regret that I have been unable to obtain any full results of these Championships, despite ordering a report, and thus I am unable to report how any Hampshire players got on in general.

The British Championship was again won a convincing style by Dr J. Penrose of Hampstead with R.D. Keene and W.R. Hartston equal second. Equal 4th were M.J. Haygarth, P.N. Lee and P.H. Clarke. These all being wellknown Chess personalities, there were few to no surprises.

The Ladies title was won by Miss D. Dobson of Northwood, leading from Mrs R.M. Bruce and Miss P.A. Sunnuchs by a full point.

The British Junior Championship (Under 21) was won by L. de Veauce, a full point ahead of four others on $7\frac{1}{2}$ pts.

The British Boys Under 18 resulted in a win for M.J. Corden with 9 points, R. Bellin $8\frac{1}{2}$ points and S.J. Hutchings third with 8 pts. Hampshire's S. Saverymuttu did not find his best form in this contest.

Miss M. Saverymuttu, Seth's sister, however, sailed through the Congress to win the British Girls Under 18 title and both her games in the Girls International two rounds tournament.

Scotland won the Girls International in the end after a tie-splitting arrangement to separate them from England with a similar number of points.

The 'Over 50' Tournament was won by F. Jaeck with 10 out of 10 from W.G. Whitaker, 8 pts.

PAIGNTON CONGRESS

This Congress was won by M. MacDonald Ross of Harrow with a score of $5\frac{1}{2}$ points from the seven rounds. Equal second were R.G. Eales of Chester and N.J. Holloway of Plympton with 5 points. I understand generally the Swiss Premier was not one of the strongest in recent years.

Hampshire's C.R. Orchard of Bournemouth scored $3\frac{1}{2}$ points.

The Challengers A 7 Rounds Swiss was won by P.D. Ralph of Cambridge and J.H. Pollitt of Stockport was second with 5 pts. The new British Ladies Champion, Miss Dobson, was third with $4\frac{1}{2}$ pts.

The Challengers B was shared by P. Hershman of Southend and R.C. Lynn of Croydon. The Winchester King Alfred's College player scored $2\frac{1}{2}$ pts in this section, P.F. Habershon.

G.H. Bennett of Bournemouth won the Premier Reserves 'A' with maximum points for the 7 Rounds. J.R. Harris of London was second with 5 pts.

The Major Swiss was won by J.F. Brown of Blackburn with $5\frac{1}{2}$ pts whilst our S.L. Russell of Romsey and Winchester scored $4\frac{1}{2}$ pts. G.L. Pritchard of Southampton returned $3\frac{1}{2}$ pts and E.G. Potter of Fareham 2 pts.

J.P. Knee of Salisbury won the First Class 'A' and C. Richards of Poole the First Class 'B'.

The Second Class was won by A. Mercer of Holywell. This class was notable in that half of the 14 entrants were Ladies.

SOUTHEND 'SLATER' TOURNAMENT

This tournament was arranged by a prominent businessman to encourage England's young Chess talent by offering a prize of £250 for the first place.

R.D. Keene of Cambridge University and Mushrooms won convincingly with $7\frac{1}{2}$ points, W.R. Hartston of Cambridge University and Southgate second with 6 pts. M.J. Basman and P.N. Lee tied for third place with 5 pts. A.J. Whiteley of Oxford University scored $3\frac{1}{2}$ pts and D. Wright of Islington 1 pt.

It is indeed pleasant to find somebody willing to sponsor and encourage our up-and-coming players.

BOURNEMOUTH KNIGHTS

Their Club Champion this year is G.H. Bennett, who joined that club for friendly games only - he plays for Portcastrians in the Bournemouth League.

KINSON

The Kinson Champion this year is D.P. Lock, their strongest graded player to play for them in the Bournemouth League.

RINGWOOD

It is understood the new Chairman of this Club will be Mr Nelson, a wellknown figure there for many years. Their retiring Chairman goes to America later this year. All will join me in wishing Mr C.E. Smith a pleasant time in the New World.

PORTSMOUTH LEAGUE

Their Individual Champion was Mr M.M. March of Portsmouth Chess Club after winning the 'Congress' Section of the Tournament and going on to beat Mr A.D. Crossin of Waterlooville Chess Club, who won the 'Home-Venue' Section. M.M. March beat A.D. Crossin 4-0 in a six games match organised and controller by Mr T.E. Hollington.
