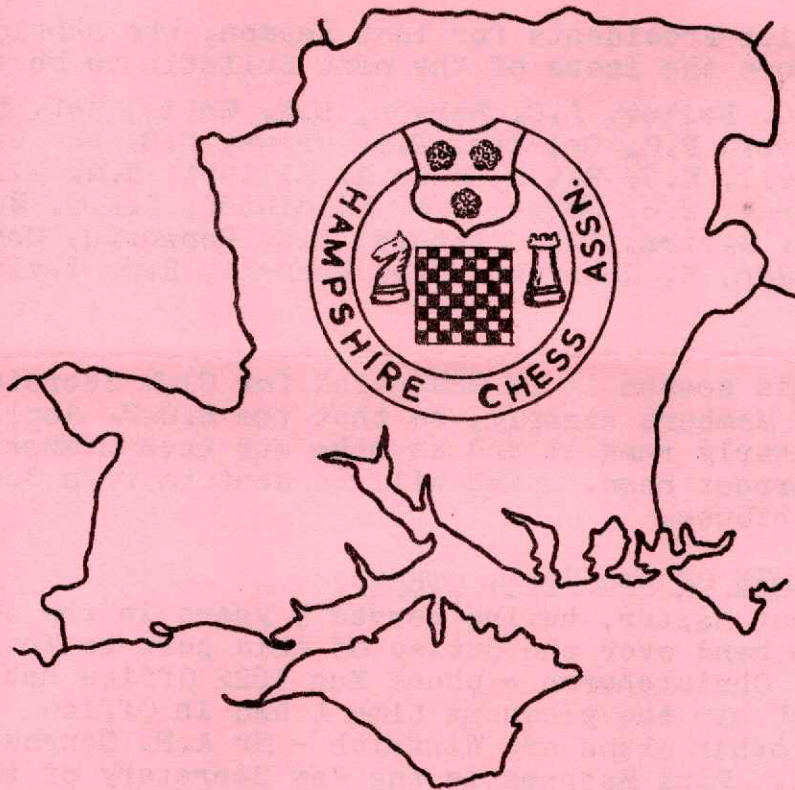

This six Rounds Swiss Tournament will be played over the 27th to 29th October, both dates inclusive, at the Reception Room, Southampton University. Entry fee is £2.50 with a first prize of £80, 2nd £30, 3rd £15, 4th £10 and four grade prizes for Under 185, Under 170, Under 155 and Ungraded. Ladies prize of £10 if three or more enter. Under-16 and Under-14 prizes of £7.50 Each. Something Chess players should not miss with a chance for all to get among the prizes.

Rate of play is 50 moves in two hours - unfinished games to be completed in ten minutes per each player.
1st Round 7.30 PM on Friday 27th and entries close Oct 23rd.
