



Major Championship Issues Resolved

THE two major championship issues have finally been resolved—Young Pompeians are champions of Hampshire, and Portsmouth Chess Club regain the championship of Portsmouth and District.

This has been a truly remarkable season, with the tension maintained right up to the last moment in both competitions. Both for a while no doubt both Farnham and Portsmouth had a chance of winning the "double," but they must now content that the Hampshire League Trophy has at last come to the Portsmouth district.

PORTSMOUTH LEAGUE

Portsmouth "A" and Cosham "A" scored 4-1 wins on their last matches, and thus Cosham and Farnham, with only 2½ game points separating them, had the closest race of the year. This is the closest contest since 1960 when Farnham "A" beat Farnham "B" by 1 point, winning in Division H, while Farnham "C" won their final match against Farnham "B" in Division One, thereby taking first place.

In the Schools' Section, Portsmouth Grammar School beat Gosport and Portsea "A" to take the Hampshire Schools' title with 4½ points.

2. P—K5 P—R5 1½
This week we have an interesting position arrived at in a recent game between J. H. Jones (Gosport) and D. A. Rawden (Portsmouth). His opponent Black is a pawn up and has the move.

Because any other move appears to be bad, he plays 1...N5-4. White cannot afford to let his opponent's rook go loose and is obliged to play K—R5. Thereupon Black plays R5-K5, repeating black alternating between N5 and R5 and White between R2 and N2.
